Consideration of Resolution 2017-04, Establish Underground and Buried Utility District, *Christine Owens, Dir. of Planning & Dev.* – This is a resolution that will establish an underground and buried utility district. Senate Bill 231 was approved and it stated that if we ever want to require utilities underground that we have to do it by May 1<sup>st</sup>. There are provisions in the Bill that will restrict what we can regulate through permitting authority. This will require us to make some changes to our district ordinances to our town code. This resolution is up for consideration today.
